

## **CORONAVIRUS UPDATE – JULY 10, 2020**

<u>PLANS FOR REGATHERING!</u> For the continued health and safety of our congregation, we plan to *SLOWLY* phase in returning to normal group activities. Until further notice, we will continue in-person Sunday morning worship service and the Wednesday evening livestream only. Other group activities and monthly fellowships are suspended. Please check back often for updates.

- **SUNDAYS:** We are currently meeting in the sanctuary for our 11:00am worship service; however, there is no nursery, children's church, choir or fellowship time. Please remain in the sanctuary and use the front doors only to enter and exit the building. The restrooms in the foyer are available for use but the water fountain is not. Please observe social distancing guidelines and choose seating for your family accordingly. If you have been sick, have been around anyone who is sick, are not feeling well or simply do not feel comfortable being inside yet, please stay home and join us online.
