Thank you to everyone that joined our livestream this past Sunday. We have exciting news regarding our morning worship on Sunday, March 29. We are currently making arrangements for a DRIVE IN CHURCH SERVICE at 11:00am. You can <u>come as you are and stay in your car</u>! We will also livestream the service as usual on Facebook. All other group gatherings on our campus continue to be suspended through the end of March. We will provide updates as new information becomes available so check back often.

Through much prayer and consideration, your church leadership is making decisions with the health and safety of the congregation in mind. The following changes are in effect through the end of March:

- On Sunday, March 29, we plan to hold a DRIVE IN CHURCH SERVICE where you can be on campus but remain in your car. You will be able to tune in to a designated radio station and listen to the service. As always, we will livestream the service at 11:00am which can be viewed on our <u>Facebook page</u>. There will be no Sunday School, Awana or any other activities in the afternoon or evening.
- 2. On Wednesday, March 25, there will be no meal, service or any other group gatherings.
- 3. There will be no Men's bible study on Monday, March 23 or March 30 and no Women's bible study on Tuesday, March 24 or March 31.
- 4. The Spring Fling Vendor Fair and the Survivor Dinner, both scheduled for March 28, have been postponed.
