- **SUNDAY MAY 24:** 11:00am worship service returns to the sanctuary. No nursery, children's church, choir or fellowship time. Please remain in the sanctuary and use the front doors only to enter and exit the building. Only the restrooms in the foyer will be available. The water fountain will not be available. Please observe social distancing guidelines and choose seating for your family accordingly. If you have been sick, been around anyone who is sick, are not feeling well or simply don't feel comfortable being inside yet, please stay home and watch online. The service will be livestreamed on Facebook and later posted on our YouTube channel.
